Thank you for submitting the requested information received by Ohio EPA on January 7, 2011. You submitted this information in response to my October 22, 2010, Notice of Violation Letter. In your response, you included a copy of the paint booth filters sampling results. According to the results, you will be managing the filter waste as a solid waste. You also addressed the issue of concern by stating that you will be taking your spent fluorescent light bulbs to be recycled at Environmental Recycling, Inc. in Bowling Green.
