Thank you for submitting the requested information received by Ohio EPA on March 10 and 30, 2011. You submitted this information in response to my September 14, 2010, Notice of Violation Letter. In your response submittal, you included photographs showing the proper labeling of the used oil storage containers, and a statement that the used pick-up will be managed by Complete Waste Disposal Company, Inc. which in turns will have Everclear Oil recycled it. You also included documentation regarding the managing of your spent light bulbs as universal waste.


My review of this documentation reveals that Summit Motorsports Park has now abated all the violations discovered during the August 23, 2010, inspection as listed below:
