
Actions Required As A Result of the Above Violation	
Step 1	Within 30 days issue the attached public notice of the violation in accordance with Rule 3745-81-32 of the Ohio Administrative Code by the following methods <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. continuous posting, mail, or other direct delivery; and 2. if necessary, the system must also use any other method reasonably calculated to reach all persons served by the water system. <p>The language in italics on the attached public notice is mandatory and must be included as written.</p>
Step 2	Within ten (10) days of completing Step 1 above, fill out the attached verification form and send along with a copy of the public notification issued to the Southwest District Office of the Ohio EPA.

If samples were taken, we have not received the results. Please forward a copy of the results to my office. Late reporting is a reporting violation, but if the sample was taken you will not need to post the attached public notice.

Subject: Failure to Monitor Drinking Water
