
On September 1, 2011, I inspected the wastewater discharge at your facility on Hoffman Road, Toledo, Lucas County.

There was no discharge from the outfall at the facility's sedimentation pond. The pond water had a brown color and a brownish tint when stirred.

The sample results submitted with your permit renewal application, which were collected December 28 2010, indicate elevated concentrations for the following parameters: Suspended solids, dissolved solids, chemical oxygen demand, Total Iron, and detectable concentrations for the following parameters: Arsenic, Total Chromium, Total Copper, Total Lead, Total Nickel, and Total Zinc. To better evaluate the need to regulate these pollutants, a second sample should be collected and analyzed with results submitted to this office, by December 1, 2011. This data will be used to process the NPDES permit application.
