Dear Mr. Kyanko:

This letter is written in follow up to an Industrial storm water inspection I conducted at Scioto Materials, Plant 50096 in Westerville, Ohio on February 19, 2009. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, I noted the following:

Asphalt Stock Pile:

- I am concerned regarding the apparent recycled asphalt pile located in attached Photo Figure 1. At this time, I am formally requesting additional information regarding the Best Management Practice chosen in your Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan to address this concern.
- I am recommending the use of an extended water quality pond to minimize the threat to storm water contamination, or demonstrate an approvable alternative.
