

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

This letter is written as a follow up to a complaint investigation, I conducted at your property off Groves Road in Columbus, Ohio on February 20, 2007. The complainant alleged storm contamination resulting from the stockpiles on your property. In accordance with 40 CFR 122.26 and my site observations, the following items will require attention:

Storm Water Permit Coverage:

This facility may require coverage under our General Storm Water Permit Associated with Industrial Activities. Coverage is determined based on your Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) Code. Please include your SIC Code in your response letter. The Notice of Intent (NOI) forms and Industrial Permit can be found at <http://www.epa.state.oh.us/dsw/storm/stormform.html>. In the event coverage is required, a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan for this facility will be required.

Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP):

A SWPPP must be developed as a condition of the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Industrial Activities. The SWPPP identifies all potential threats to storm water quality. The SWPPP includes a list of all materials and associated handling, exposed to storm water. The plan also includes all external processes associated with your facility which poses a contamination threat to storm water. A list of Best Management Practices (BMP's), both current and future, designed to minimize storm water contamination must be inclusive in the SWPPP. A site map must be developed addressing all storm water outfalls and associated drainage areas. Each drainage area must be delineated to ensure all BMP's are properly designed. Please indicate in your response letter which measures will be taken to minimize this threat. A vegetative cover, or alternative, will be required for the inactive areas of the stockpile.


