This letter is written to inform you I conducted a site evaluation of your concerns associated with apparent construction activities along State Route 739 in Logan County. The inspection was conducted on November 28, 2006 to determine if this activity would require specific permits issued by Ohio EPA.

During the inspection I noted a recent area which had been bush hauled within the last seven to ten days. However, this activity did not result in an earth disturbing activity as defined by the conditions in 40 CFR 122.26.

At this time no further action will be required for this site. If you have any further questions regarding this inspection or this site please do not hesitate to contact me at our Central District Office (614) 728-3844.



This letter is written as a follow up to a storm water inspection conducted by Pamela Olson, with Ohio EPA, at Superkick Soccer & Sports Performance, on December 5, 2006. This construction site located in Delaware County is currently covered under the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. Based on the site inspections and the conditions set forth in the General Permit, the following items will require attention:

**Sediment and Erosion Controls:**


1. Given the time of year alternate erosion control measures such as erosion control matting, crimped mulching, mulch with netting and/or tackifier, or an approvable alternative must be implement for this site to ensure effective erosion control for the upcoming winter months.
2. During the inspection it was noted that the perimeter sediment controls had failed (see figure 1). Measures must be taken to ensure all sediment and erosion controls are maintained within three days from receipt of this letter.

**Post Construction:**

The General Permit mandates specific water quality treatment for storm water following the completion of construction (see attachment). Please be able to demonstrate that your post construction requirements per the General Permit will be met. Please submit to my attention, the water quality calculations demonstrating compliance.
