



Dear Sir or Madame:

This letter is written as a follow up to a storm water inspection I conducted at the McDonalds, located at 1401 North Memorial Drive, in Lancaster, Ohio on October 31, 2006. On that date, I noted the external washing operations at this site.

Please be aware that wash water associated with this process would be considered a process waste water and not authorized for discharge to waters of the state, or an associated conveyance such as a separate storm sewer or ditch, without permission from the Director of Ohio EPA via an NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System) Permit. I did note a migration of wash water towards a storm sewer system located on your property (see attached photo).






Figure 1 Waste wash water noted migrating towards storm sewer which serves a direct conduit to the Hocking River
