Dear Mr. Nolan:

On October 23, 2008, I performed a compliance inspection at your facility to determine its compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste and solid waste laws and regulations as found in Chapter 3734. of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745. of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). This letter will explain the hazardous waste violations found and what you need to do to correct the violations.

Based on this inspection, you are in violation of the following hazardous waste regulations:

- (1) **OAC Rule 3745-279-22(C), Used oil storage requirements for generators:**  
Containers and aboveground tanks used to store used oil at generator facilities shall be labeled or marked clearly with the words, "Used Oil."

Containers (55-gallon drums) were not labeled with the words "Used Oil", in violation of this rule. This violation was corrected during the inspection. Therefore, JR's Truck Parts has adequately demonstrated compliance with this rule.

As we discussed during the inspection, spent fluorescent lamps can be managed as a universal waste. Universal waste rules can be found on Ohio EPA's web page at <http://www.epa.state.oh.us/dhwm/guidancedocs.html#UW>.

You may be able to reduce the waste your company generates. If you find ways to recycle, reduce or altogether eliminate the amount of waste that your company generates you may be able to reduce treatment and disposal costs. And, you may possibly reduce your regulatory requirements. The Ohio EPA strongly encourages pollution prevention as the preferred approach for waste management. The first priority of pollution prevention is to eliminate the generation of wastes and pollutants at the source (source reduction). For wastes or pollutants that are generated, the second priority is to recycle or reuse them in an environmentally sound manner. You may benefit economically, help preserve the environment, and improve your public image by implementing pollution prevention

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programs.
