Dear Mr. Anderson:

On October 20, 2009, Scott Bergreen and I performed a compliance inspection of American Electric Power's General Gavin Plant to determine its compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws and regulations as found in Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

Based on our observations and review of facility documentation during this inspection, Ohio EPA issued a Notice of Violation on October 27, 2009. I received Doug Workman's email containing the photographs of the used oil cleanup and the spent bulbs properly labeled and dated, on October 25, 2009. Based on this documentation, the Gavin Plant has returned to compliance with the following regulations:

- i) OAC rule 3745-273-15(C) Accumulation time limits – standards for small quantity handlers of universal waste;
- ii) OAC rule 3745-273-14 (E), Labeling/marking standards for small quantity handlers of universal waste; and
- iii) OAC Rule 3745-279-22(D), Used oil storage requirements for generators.

The Gavin Plant has now abated all violations cited from the October 20, 2009 inspection.
