Dear Mrs. Logue:

On March 14, 2007, I performed a compliance evaluation inspection of your facility to determine its compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws and regulations, as found in the Ohio Revised Code and the Ohio Administrative Code (ORC and OAC, respectively). Trevor Irwin of the Division of Solid and Infectious Waste Management accompanied me and evaluated your business for compliance with solid waste regulations.

During the inspection, the following violation of hazardous waste rules was discovered:

- (1) **Off-site shipments of used oil by generators** OAC rule 3745-279-24(B). Generators may transport, without a U.S. EPA identification number, used oil that is generated at the generator's site to a used oil collection center...

You stated that your used oil has been transported to Red's Rollen Garage for use in their oil-burner. However, that is not a facility that has notified Ohio EPA as a used oil collection center. The closest such collection centers that accept oil from businesses are located in Columbus and Cincinnati (see attached list). To demonstrate compliance with this rule, either state which listed facility you will transport your oil to, provide the name and location of a registered used oil transporter that you will use to pick up your oil, or cease generating used oil by having your trucks serviced at a facility that will properly manage it.

**General Comment:**

During the inspection, we observed a five gallon bucket outside the garage door that appeared to be full of water and used oil. The used oil rules (see attached fact sheet) require you to try to prevent releases and quickly clean up and dispose of contaminated soil when releases do occur. Used oil should never be stored outside in open containers. Please state what you have done to address the material in this bucket to prevent release.

Please provide this information **within 30 days** of your receipt of this letter.

Also during this inspection, you stated that later this spring, the solid wastes and recyclable materials on your property were to be removed for proper disposal. You also stated that any scrap tires generated from your business are taken to the Rumpke Beech Hollow Landfill in Jackson County.




