Dear Mrs. Logue:

On March 14, 2007, I performed a compliance evaluation inspection of your facility to determine its compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws and regulations, as found in the Ohio Revised Code and the Ohio Administrative Code (ORC and OAC, respectively). Trevor Irwin of the Division of Solid and Infectious Waste Management accompanied me and evaluated your business for compliance with solid waste regulations.

On March 22, 2007, a Notice of Violation (NOV) letter was sent to you for not using a registered used oil transporter. On April 23, 2007, I received your response to the NOV in which you stated that you would be using Glockner Oil Company for transporting your used oil. Therefore, you have returned to compliance with the following regulation:

- i. Off-site shipments of used oil by generators OAC rule 3745-279-24(B).
