Dear Mr. Meade:

On May 3, 2007, Trevor Irwin (Division of Solid and Infectious Waste Management) and I performed a compliance inspection to determine your facility's compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws regulations as found in Chapter 3734. of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745. of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). This letter will explain the violations we found and what you need to do to correct the violations.

Based on this inspection, a Notice of Violation letter was sent to you on May 14, 2007. I received your response on June 14, 2007. Based on the information in your response and photographs, scrap tire receipts, used oil receipts, you have returned to compliance with the following regulation:

- i. OAC rule 3745-279-22(D), Response to releases.

**General Comment:**

I received the MSDS that you sent regarding the Sylvania brand bulbs that you use. Unfortunately, the information in the MSDS is not sufficient to determine that these bulbs are not hazardous waste when disposed. A specific test, the toxic characteristic leaching procedure (TCLP) must be used to determine whether the bulbs are regulated hazardous waste. Unless you can find and provide this information, these bulbs must be collected for recycling (they are then considered a universal waste; i.e., they must be collected in a closed container and labeled "universal waste lamps" until enough lamps are collected for recycling). If you have additional questions on universal waste management, please see the factsheet I provided in the previous letter for details or call me.

**Solid Waste Issues:**

During the course of this inspection, tires were observed being stored on the property. Based on the receipts you provided, you are using a licensed scrap tire hauler to properly dispose of your scrap tires.


