Dear Mr. Brabham:

On March 14, 2007, Trevor Irwin (Division of Solid and Infectious Waste Management) and I performed a compliance inspection to determine your facility's compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws regulations as found in Chapter 3734. of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745. of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). This letter will explain the violations we found and what you need to do to correct the violations.

On March 23, 2007, a Notice of Violation letter was issued for your facility. I received your response on May 7, 2007 in which you provided photographs of the used oil drum storage area showing that the drums and contaminated soils have been removed. Your letter also stated that you accept small amounts of used oil from residential use, not from businesses; this is in compliance with Ohio's used oil rules.

Based on this information, you have returned to compliance with the following hazardous waste rules:

- I) OAC rule 3745-279-22(D), Response to releases;
- II) OAC Rule 3745-279-22(C), Used oil storage requirements for generators; and
- III) OAC rule 3745-279-23, On-site burning of used oil in space heaters by generators.

**General Comments:**

- (a) You stated in your letter that you were coordinating with Dennis Deavers to address SPCC issues at this site; I need nothing more on this issue.
- (b) Your response stated that all batteries have been collected from around the property and will be recycled on a monthly basis. No additional response is needed.
- (c) Your letter did not address the oily water issue; please let me know how you managed this material (the name and address of the facility which collects or treats it).

**Solid Waste Issues:**

In your letter, you stated you have placed a storage trailer on your property to store scrap tires that are still able to be used for your business. This is acceptable. You also stated that all other scrap tires are removed by Sundown Tires. They are on the list of registered scrap tire transporters within the state of Ohio. This is also acceptable. Based on the submitted information, you are in compliance with Ohio's laws and regulations regarding scarp tire management practices.
