Dear Mr. Bichard:

On June 8, 2011, Ohio EPA received a complaint alleging that used oil is leaking from drums into soils at your property located on North Street in Winterset. On June 27, 2011, I performed a complaint investigation to determine the validity of the complaint.

Based on this investigation, I observed some spillage and leaking drums of used oil; therefore, you are in violation of the following hazardous waste regulations:

- (1) **Used oil storage requirements for generators, OAC Rule 3745-279-22(D):**
Upon detection of a release of used oil... a generator shall perform the following cleanup steps: (1) stop the release; (2) contain the released used oil; (3) clean up and properly manage the released used oil and other materials; and (4) if necessary, to prevent future releases, repair or replace any leaking used oil storage containers or tanks prior to returning them to service.
- A) I observed a drum of used oil leaking onto soil to the east of your building. The used oil in this drum must be placed into a sound container or the drum placed into an over-pack drum to prevent further release. Used oil must be transported to a proper recycling by a used oil transporter with a U.S.EPA identification number.
- B) Used oil contaminated soil from the drum discussed above and around the oil-filter pile must be dug up and disposed of at a permitted solid waste landfill. Used oil filters must be properly drained and placed into containers to prevent used oil releases. Once properly drained, they may be recycled as scrap steel or disposed at a permitted solid waste facility.

To demonstrate compliance with this rule, please provide copies of the receipts for the disposal of this soil and any used oil transported off this property. Also provide photographs off these two areas once these soils been removed (until no oil staining is visible).

- (2) Used oil storage requirements for generators, OAC rule 3745-279-22(C):
Paragraph (C): Containers and aboveground tanks used to store used oil at generator facilities shall be marked clearly with the words "Used Oil."

All containers of used oil must be properly labeled; you can demonstrate compliance with this regulation by providing photographs showing that all remaining containers of used oil have been properly labeled "Used Oil".

Please provide the documentation requested above **within thirty days** of the date of this letter.

I have attached a copy of Ohio EPA's fact sheet regarding used oil management.
