Dear Mr. Bichard:

On June 8, 2011, Ohio EPA received a complaint alleging that used oil is leaking from drums into soils at your property located on North Street in Winterset. On June 27, 2011, I performed a complaint investigation to determine the validity of the complaint.

Based on this investigation, I observed some spillage and leaking drums of used oil and unlabeled containers of used oil. Based on this information, a notice of violation letter was sent to you on June 28, 2011. On July 18, 2011, I received your response which included photographs of the spill areas with the contaminated soil removed, a receipt from Kimble Landfill for these soils, and a receipt from Heartland Petroleum for the used oil; therefore, you have abated the following violations:

- i. Used oil storage requirements for generators, OAC rule 3745-279-22(D);
- ii. Used oil storage requirements for generators, OAC rule 3745-279-22(C).

You have now returned to compliance with all regulations cited from the June 28, 2011 investigation. If you have any questions regarding waste management or pollution prevention activities, please call me at (740) 380-5278.
