Dear Mr. Guenther:

On August 14, 2006, I inspected the Dial Eastern States Aircraft Painting, Inc. (Dial Eastern) to determine its compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws as found in Chapter 3734. of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745. of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). This letter will explain the violations or compliance issues I found and what you need to do to correct them.

Based on this inspection, a Notice of Violation (NOV) letter was issued to you on August 15, 2006. Additional NOV's were issued on September 21, 2006 and May 9, 2007. We spoke on several occasions since the initial inspection regarding whether you would need to continue the use of methylene chloride (MC)-stripper. On July 20, 2007, I received your written response which states that your facility will rely on non-regulated strippers from now on. Therefore, you have abated the following violation:

- i. Waste determination, OAC 3745-52-11.

You have now abated all violations cited during the August 14, 2006 inspection.
