Dear Mr. McCune

On April 16, 2007, Ohio EPA inspected Huddles Tire and Auto Service's facility located at 12451 St. Rt. 664 S. to determine Tire and Auto Service's compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws as found in Chapter 3734. of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745. of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

The following violation of Ohio's hazardous waste laws were found during the inspection.

- (1) **OAC 3745-279-22(C)(1) Used oil containers and tanks must be labeled with the words Used Oil.** Used oil containers were not labeled with the words "used oil" upon arrival for the inspection.

Containers of used oil were properly labeled during the inspection.

Huddle's returned to compliance during the inspection.
