Re: Complaint Investigation – Illegal Disposal of Construction and Demolition Debris

Dear Mr. Rochell:

During the morning of August 9, 2011, I conducted a complaint investigation at your residence located at 8990 Marcy Road. The complaint was in regard to the dumping of landscape wastes at the rear of your property. As we discussed that morning, your company had dumped the remains of a wood deck at the back of the property. This material is considered to be construction and demolition debris and must be disposed at either a licensed solid waste landfill or a licensed construction and demolition debris landfill. The deck material must be removed within the next two weeks (by August 24, 2011). Please provide me a copy of the disposal receipt via mail or by fax at 614-728-3890.

As we also discussed, you have also dumped some stone and/or brick pavers and concrete at the back of the property. These types of items are considered to be clean hard fill and can be used to level off the property.
