Dear Mr. Arnott:

You contacted me on March 12, 2007, to let me know that you had removed all the oil-contaminated soil from the ground at A-1 Sanitation. On March 13, 2007, I conducted a follow up inspection at A-1 Sanitation and confirmed that you had completed the soil removal work, as directed by Ohio EPA's January 29, 2007 letter to you. I also observed the excavated material, which had been loaded onto a trailer for transport to the Athens-Hocking Reclamation Landfill. On March 20, 2007, and March 29, 2007, I received mailed copies of the Athens-Hocking Reclamation Landfill waste disposal record and dump ticket for the excavated material.

On March 13, 2007, we also discussed your plans to comply with Ohio's used oil disposal rules found in OAC Rule 3745-279-24. A-1 Sanitation is now renting a garage where maintenance and oil changes will be done on A-1 Sanitation's trucks. This garage is equipped with a used oil burning furnace. All used oil you generate will be used to fuel the furnace.

My review of your facility operations and the documentation you submitted reveals that A-1 Sanitation has adequately demonstrated abatement of all violations discovered during the January 24, 2007, inspection.
