Dear Mr. Curtis:

On March 30, 2009, I received a complaint which stated that you are burning solid wastes and burning and/or dumping chemicals on the ground on your property. On April 14, 2009, John Rochotte and I investigated this complaint. We observed that there is a burn area with residues of solid waste remaining on the ground (shingles, scrap lumber, bottles and cans). Additionally, we found several car and truck batteries and two drums of used oil, one of which had a hole in it.

Based on this investigation, a notice of violation letter was issued to you on April 17, 2009. On May 4, 2009, your response was received which included receipts for batteries and used oil. Based on your response, and a follow-up visit I performed on May 13, 2009, you have returned to compliance with the following hazardous waste violations:

- (i) Used oil storage requirements for generators, OAC Rule 3745-279-22(D)
- (ii) Used oil storage requirements for generators, OAC rule 3745-279-22(C)

You have now returned to compliance with all hazardous waste regulations cited from the April, 2009 complaint investigation.
