Dear Mr. Rodgers:

On November 19, 2009, Ohio EPA received a complaint alleging that used oil has been improperly stored on your property and is being released to soil. On December 2, 2009, I performed a complaint investigation of your property to determine the validity of the complaint. I also determined your facility's compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws and regulations as found in Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

Based on the observations made during the investigation, Ohio EPA issued a notice of violation letter to you on December 4, 2009. On January 4, 2010, I received your response, including photographs indicating that all the drums and the used oil tank have been properly labeled. Based on this documentation, your facility has returned to compliance with the following regulation:

- (i) Used oil storage requirements for generators, OAC rule 3745-279-22(C).
