Thank you for your February 1, 2007, response to Ohio EPA's January 18, 2007, Notice of Violation letter. The documentation you submitted included a description and record of universal waste training for your employees, including an example of the labels that you plan to use for universal waste lamps, which reads "Universal Waste-Lights". Even though during my inspection I did not observe any incorrectly labeled universal waste lamps, please note that this label should be revised to read "Universal Waste- Lamps" or other language in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3745-273-34. In addition to the above, you submitted a description of how your empty aerosol containers will be managed inside the facility. This procedure is acceptable to Ohio EPA.

My review of this documentation reveals that Kenworth Truck Company has now abated all violations discovered during the January 3 and 10, 2007 inspection.
