Dear Mr. James:

Thank you for your May 17, 2007 response to Ohio EPA's April 26, 2007 Notice of Violation letter. The documentation you submitted included a photograph of the area from which you excavated oily soils.

My review of this documentation reveals that James Automotive has now abated all violations discovered during the April 18, 2007 inspection.

GENERAL COMMENTS

In your May 17, 2007 response, you stated that you dispose of used oil by taking it to a local auto parts store. Please note that your business is a used oil generator per OAC 3745-279-20 through 3745-279-24 and as such, you may transport your used oil in quantities of 55-gallons or less to either a "registered used oil collection center" or to a used oil recycling facility only. If the auto parts store that accepts your used oil is not a "registered used oil collection center", they cannot lawfully accept your used oil. Please see the following list of used oil collection centers to verify that they are registered to accept used oil from businesses:


