Dear Mr. Burgess:

Thank you for your February 15, 2011 response to Ohio EPA's January 7, 2011 Notice of Violation letter. You submitted documentation including: revisions to the facility's Contingency Plan, and inspection records of the hazardous waste storage area. Additionally, you stated that GE Betz has not yet cleaned out the two hazardous waste storage tanks or made a final decision about future use of the tanks. You also stated that if the tanks would not be used for hazardous waste storage you would contact me for information on properly closing them as hazardous waste storage systems.

My review of this documentation reveals that GE Betz has adequately demonstrated abatement of all violations discovered during the December 14 and 15, 2010 inspection. I will follow up with you in 30 days to discuss the situation with the hazardous waste tanks.
