Dear Mr. Snyder:

On September 10, 2007, Nyall McKenna, Chris Coder, and I visited both the Canton and Bolivar, Ohio facilities. During the Bolivar site visit, we observed spent media on the ground and in a storm sewer in the loading area. I sent you a Notice of Violation (NOV) letter on October 29, 2007, specifying the violations observed during the site visit. On November 8, 2007, Ohio EPA received a response from US Technology's attorney, Ms. Laura Mills. In this response, it was stated that spent media has been cleaned from the loading area and that the loading of trucks will occur inside the building. To adequately abate the violations cited in the October 29, 2007 Notice of Violation, US Technology must provide the documentation as requested below:

1. **Ohio Revised Code § 3734.02 (E) and (F), Prohibitions:** (E) No person shall establish or operate a hazardous waste facility for the storage, treatment, or disposal of any hazardous waste, without obtaining a hazardous waste facility installation and operation permit. (F) No person shall store, treat, or dispose of hazardous waste identified or listed under this chapter and rules adopted under it, regardless of whether generated on or off the premises where the waste is stored, treated, or disposed of, or transport or cause to be transported any hazardous waste identified or listed under this chapter and rules adopted under it to any other premises except to a hazardous waste facility operating under a permit issued in accordance with this chapter.


As a result of the disposal of hazardous waste onto the ground without a permit, closure plans, in lieu of a hazardous waste facility installation and operation permit, for all the disposal areas discussed above must be developed and submitted to Ohio EPA for review and approval. This closure plan must be submitted in compliance with OAC rule 3745-55-12.

Also, please provide disposal receipts or a hazardous waste manifest for the collected spent blasting media.

Please submit the above requested documentation to this office **within 15 days** of receipt of this letter demonstrating that all violations have been abated.
