Dear Mr. Shepherd:

On July 23, 2008, I inspected R&J Cylinder & Machine Inc.'s facility in Dover, Ohio to determine R&J Cylinder & Machine Inc.'s compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws as found in Chapter 3734, of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745. of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). During the inspection, I also helped you identify ways to prevent pollution by reducing waste. The inspection included an inspection of facility operations.

During the inspection, the following violation was observed:

- (1) **Used oil storage requirements for generators, OAC rule 375-279-22(C)**: Containers and aboveground tanks used to store used oil at generator facilities shall be labeled or marked clearly.

During the inspection, the used oil tank was not labeled as required by this rule. R&J Cylinder, however, labeled the used oil tank during the inspection; therefore, no further action by R&J Cylinder is required.
