Dear Mr. Yoder:

Thank you for your May 29, 2009 response to Ohio EPA's April 23, 2009, Notice of Violation letter. You submitted documentation including: a revised contingency plan, a list of those receiving the contingency plan, a plan for ensuring that satellite accumulation containers will not be open when waste is not being added or removed, photos of the satellite accumulation containers, a photo of the closed 55-gallon hazardous waste storage drum in the <90 day storage area, weekly inspection logs for the <90 day storage area, a photo of labeled used oil storage drums, a correction of information provided about used oil disposal, a manifest documenting disposal of used oil by Chemical Solvents, a photo of closed and labeled fluorescent lamp universal waste containers, and land disposal restriction forms for each hazardous waste stream generated by ProVia.

My review of this documentation reveals that ProVia has adequately demonstrated abatement of all violations discovered during the March 26 and April 9, 2009 inspection.

In addition, based on additional information provided by ProVia on used oil disposal and on additional information obtained by Ohio EPA during an inspection of ProVia's oil supplier, Swiss Valley Oil, Ohio EPA is retracting the April 23, 2009 citation of **OAC Rule 3745-279-24, Off-Site Shipments of Used Oil by Generators.**
