Dear Mr. Marek:

Thank you for your response received on June 28, 2010 to Ohio EPA's May 27, 2010 Notice of Violation (NOV) letter. The documentation you submitted included a description of the revised inspection form and retraining of inspectors, and of corrective actions taken and the results of an internal investigation to address a broken pipeline discovered during the May 3, 2010 Ohio EPA inspection of Cyttec.

My review of this documentation reveals that Cyttec has now abated all violations discovered during the May 3, 2010 inspection.

**GENERAL COMMENTS**

On September 3, 2009, Ohio EPA received Cyttec's *2009 Groundwater Monitoring Interim Report for RCRA Part B Permitted Status Integrated Groundwater Monitoring Program*. The September 2009 Report summarizes groundwater-related activities and results of groundwater sampling conducted during the first half of 2009. The semiannual compliance monitoring event for the first half 2009 was conducted in May 2009.

On February 26, 2010 Ohio EPA received the document titled *Supplementary Annual Report for 2009 Final Standards Groundwater Monitoring Information*. The February 2010 Report documents Cyttec's ground water monitoring program including sampling results, laboratory reports, statistical trend analyses, and potentiometric maps for May and November 2009. A CD containing the five required data bases in an Excel format and all laboratory data reports were also submitted with the Annual Report. On March 4, 2010, SEDO received a revised CD that corrects the laboratory omissions of some matrix spike and matrix spike duplicate data.

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The groundwater elevation and quality data for the May and November 2009 monitoring events are generally consistent with previous data. Ohio EPA has determined that Cytec's Interim and Annual Reports meet the requirements of OAC Rules 3745-54-75, 54-77(C), and 54-97(J).
