Dear Mr. Marek:

On August 22, 2007, Ohio EPA visited a portion of the Cytec Marietta facility along Hunter Avenue and noted that the required security signs were unsatisfactorily posted at the perimeter of the site. The Part B permit condition B.4 requires that Cytec comply with the Security provisions of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-54-14 and Section F of the Part B permit application. As a result, Ohio EPA has determined that Cytec is in violation of the following:

- 1) **OAC Rule 3745-54-14(C), Security:** Unless the owner or operator has made a successful demonstration under paragraphs (A)(1) and (A)(2) of this rule, a sign with the legend, "Danger – Unauthorized Personnel Keep Out," must be posted at each entrance to the active portion of a facility, and at other locations, in sufficient numbers to be seen from any approach in the active portion. The legend must be written in English and be legible from a distance of at least twenty-five feet.

Cytec does have some signs posted at the site, however, many of the signs are faded, broken, or have fallen to the ground. Others are covered by weeds and/or woody vegetation, obscuring them from view. Cytec shall make sure that adequate signs are posted at the perimeter of the site to meet the Part B requirements and the Security requirements in OAC 3745-54-14. Cytec shall submit documentation to Ohio EPA, in the form of photographs indicating the signs have been posted, **within 30 days** of your receipt of this letter.
