Dear Mr. Ward:

I received Skuttle Manufacturing's response to my September 6, 2007 Notice of Violation (NOV) letter on September 17, 2007. The documentation you submitted included photographs indicating boxes of universal waste fluorescent bulbs were properly closed and labeled. In addition, Skuttle Manufacturing submitted information indicating a system is in place to document how long universal waste lamps have been stored on-site by placing the date on the box when the first spent bulb is placed in the box.

My review of this documentation reveals that Skuttle Manufacturing has adequately demonstrated abatement of the following violations discovered during the August 27, 2007 inspection:

- (1) **OAC 3745-273-13(D)(1), Waste Management – Standards for Small Quantity Handlers of Universal Waste**
- (2) **OAC 3745-273-14(E), Labeling/Marking – Standards for Small Quantity Handlers of Universal Waste**
- (3) **OAC 3745-273-15(C), Accumulation Time Limits – Standards for Small Quantity Handlers of Universal Waste**

Skuttle Manufacturing has resolved all violations resulting from the August 27, 2007 inspection.
