Dear Mr. Potochnik:


On June 19, 2009, Jim Sferra and I visited Solvay Advanced Polymers' (Solvay) facility in Marietta, Ohio and met with you and Jean Anderson to conduct a quarterly review of Solvay's Part B Hazardous Waste Permit. The purpose of this letter is to document our visit and follow up on the issues covered during the visit.

During the quarterly visit, we toured the manufacturing areas of the plant and the wastewater treatment plant area. While at the wastewater treatment plant, we looked at the condition of the Former Equalization Basin's (FEQB) final cover. Since Ohio EPA's March 3, 2008 annual permit inspection, Solvay had been in violation of Permit Condition G.3, Post-Closure Procedures and Use of Property for failing to maintain the integrity and effectiveness of the FEQB's final cover. During our visit, we observed the repairs that had been made to the cover, which included grading to improve drainage and restored vegetation. Based on our observations of the improvements made to the FEQB cover, Ohio EPA has determined that Solvay is returned to compliance with Permit Condition G.3, Post-Closure Procedures and Use of Property.
