Dear Mr. Schneeberger:

I received your response to my February 27, 2008 Notice of Violation (NOV) letter on March 10, 2008 and March 19, 2008. The documentation you submitted included receipts and manifest from Global Environmental Assurance Inc. and TCLP metals results for a spent paint booth filter.

My review of this documentation reveals that Zides Screen Printing has adequately demonstrated abatement of the following violation discovered during the February 15, 2008 inspection:

**OAC Rule 3745-52-11, Hazardous Waste Determination**

Zides Screen Printing has resolved all violations resulting from the February 15, 2008 inspection.

**GENERAL COMMENT**

- a) Zides Screen Printing is a Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator. Based on the manifests and waste receipts you submitted, the last manifest date for waste paint was a shipment on July 21, 2004. You indicated to me that Global Environmental picked up waste paint from Zides on subsequent occasions, but the receipts were labeled "non hazardous ink" or "waste ink", instead of as waste paint. Waste ink and waste paint is picked up by Global Environmental Assurance and sent to a permitted hazardous waste facility in South Carolina for fuels blending. For proper recordkeeping, Zides Screen Printing should identify the material on future manifests or receipts as waste paint or waste flammable liquid. The correct hazardous waste codes should also accompany the waste paint description (i.e., D001/F003/F005) so Zides can track waste generation amounts and have proper documentation that wastes were properly disposed of.
