Dear Mr. Kandel:

On April 28, 2008, Ohio EPA received Solvay Advanced Polymers, LLC's (Solvay) response to Ohio EPA's March 21, 2008 notice of violation. Documentation submitted included written descriptions of steps taken to correct violations and copies of training records.

A review of this documentation reveals that Solvay has adequately demonstrated abatement of the following violations discovered during Ohio EPA's March 3, 2008 inspection:

- OAC Rule 3745-54-15, General Inspection Requirements; Permit Condition B.5, General Inspection Requirements; and Permit Conditions E.5., Inspection Schedules and Procedures
- Permit Condition C. 6, Containment Systems
- OAC Rule 3745-54-15, General Inspection Requirements; and Permit condition C. 8, Inspection Schedules and Procedures
- OAC Rule 3745-66-73(A), Management of Containers
- OAC Rule 3745-66-74, Inspections

Solvay submitted a schedule for returning to compliance for the violation of **Permit Condition G. 3, Post-Closure Procedures and Use of the Property**. This includes scheduling a conference call to discuss road placement on the landfill cap and a schedule for re-grading the surface by June 30. Solvay will remain in violation of **Permit Condition G. 3, Post-Closure Procedures and Use of the Property** until these actions have been taken. Please submit documentation that this violation has been abated by July 4, 2008.
