RE: MIAMI COUNTY SOLID WASTE TRANSFER STATION INSPECTION REPORT

Dear County Commissioners:

An inspection of the Miami County Transfer Station was performed on August 25, 2010. This quarterly inspection was conducted to evaluate compliance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-23. The following violation was noted at the time of the inspection:

1. During the inspection it was noted that mosquito larvae was present in scrap tires located in a dumpster provided by Rumpke Scrap Tire Transporter. The dumpster was approximately three fourths full. Paperwork provided during the inspection showed that the container was received at the facility on July 29, 2010 and it was stated that the last time tires were treated at the facility was July 5, 2010. The presence of mosquito larvae in scrap tires is a violation of OAC 3745-27-60(C)(2), which states in part;

Maintain mosquito control by keeping all tires dry or by continuing applications of a pesticide or larvicide to all scrap tires stored outdoors at no greater than thirty-day intervals or as recommended by the manufacturer or formulator.

At the time of the inspection granular larvicide was used for treatment of the scrap tires and the violation was abated. In the future it is recommended that the scrap tires be kept dry but if this cannot occur please follow OAC 3745-27-60 in reference to treatment requirements.


