Dear Mr. Roush:

On April 13, 2011, I conducted a large generator of infectious waste re-inspections at the above mentioned facility. This inspection was conducted in order to determine compliance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-27, specifically rules governing large generators of infectious waste. The following comments are a result of the inspection:

1. During the re-inspection the infectious waste shipping papers for the lab and storage area located on the first floor were reviewed.
2. Three years worth of shipping papers were available for inspection at the lab. However, the returned white copy of the shipping papers for the last four (4) months were not being matched up with the gold copy. Once the lab staff went through their unopened mail they were able to locate the missing white copies and match the two copies together. Please educate the staff in regards to the requirements for the infectious waste shipping papers.
