
Dear Ms. Tudor:

On January 20, 2011, I conducted a large generator of infectious waste re-inspection at the above mentioned facility. This inspection was conducted in order to determine compliance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-27, specifically rules governing large generators of infectious waste. Violations and comments are documented in this letter.

1. A biohazard spill kit was provided **please ensure that caution tape is included with the kit.**
2. The infectious waste shipping papers were reviewed and the generator ID number was not provided on the shipping paper. This is a violation of OAC Rule 3745-27-33(B)(2), which states in part that "The treatment shipping paper shall: Be legible and complete." Please contact your IW hauler to have this preprinted on the forms.
3. The spill cleanup procedure could not be located at the time of the inspection. The staff contacted their main office for help locating the procedure. It may be beneficial to post the procedure in addition to placing it in the manual.
