Notice of Violation**

Dear Ms. Tudor:

On October 12, 2011, I conducted a large generator of infectious waste re-inspection at the above mentioned facility. This inspection was conducted in order to determine compliance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-27, specifically rules governing large generators of infectious waste.

The infectious waste shipping papers were reviewed and the generator ID number still is not provided on the shipping paper. This continues as a violation of OAC Rule 3745-27-33(B) (2), which states in part that "The treatment shipping paper shall: Be legible and complete." Please contact your IW hauler to have this preprinted on the forms and until such time this is corrected the generator number must be handwritten onto the forms. In addition, staff at the facility has changed. Please review with the staff the requirements to match up the IW shipping papers left at the facility and the final copy which is returned to the generator, along with the other rule requirements.

A re-inspection will be conducted at the facility. Please respond in writing within 15 days of receipt of this violation letter stating how you will correct this violation. If you have any questions, please contact me at (937)285-6094.
