Period **Notice of Violation**

Dear Mr. McMillan:

Fraser Papers Inc. is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-30-08(C)(8) which requires analytical results, statistical results, and ground water elevation data to be submitted not later than seventy-five days (75-days) after sampling the well. The facility sampled wells the week of November 18-22, 2010, and **should have submitted results by February 1, 2011**. However, results were not received by Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Southwest District Office (SWDO) until April 19, 2011, or one hundred fifty-two days (152-days) after sampling. In order for future reports to achieve compliance with this requirement, the facility owner/operator must submit future semiannual reports within seventy-five days (75-days) of sampling.
