**RE: Village of Cedarville Closed Landfill, Notice of Violation**

Dear Mr. Terrell:

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) has not received a 2008 Annual Report or ground water data from 2006 through the present. Failure to submit the 2008 Annual Report on or before April 1, 2009 is a violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-14(A)(6), which states in part;

*Submitting a report to the appropriate Ohio EPA district office and approved health department and placing a copy into the operating record not later than the first day of April of each year, which contains the following:*

*(a) If a leachate collection system exists, a summary of the quantity of leachate collected for treatment and disposal on a monthly basis during the year, and the location of leachate treatment and/or disposal.*

*(b) If a leachate collection system exists, results of analytical testing of an annual grab sample of leachate for the parameters specified in appendix I of rule 3745-27-10 of the Administrative Code. The grab sample shall be obtained from the leachate management system.*

*(c) The most recent updated post-closure cost estimate adjusted for inflation and for any change in the post-closure cost estimate required by rule 3745-27-16 of the Administrative Code.*

Failure to submit and/or conduct ground water sampling is a violation of OAC Rule 3745-27-14(A)(5), which states in part;


*... the owner, operator, or permittee shall conduct post-closure care activities at the sanitary landfill facility for a minimum of thirty years... Post-closure care activities for a sanitary landfill facility shall include, but are not limited to the following:*

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*Fulfilling all monitoring and reporting requirements in accordance with rule  
3745-27-10 of the Administrative Code for ground water...*

The 2008 Annual Operational Report and all missing ground water reports are to be submitted to my attention. Please respond in writing within 15 days of receipt of this correspondence. If you have any questions, please call me at (937) 285-6094.
