Dear Mr. Vandersall:

Countywide RDF's original permit to install was issued by Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) on May 18, 1989. Ohio Administrative Code 3745-27-19(N) states, in part, "Upon every tenth anniversary of the initial permit to install issued to the owner or operator of the sanitary landfill facility pursuant to Chapter 3734. of the Revised Code and each tenth anniversary thereafter, the owner or operator shall submit to Ohio EPA an analysis demonstrating that the design of the unconstructed portions of the sanitary landfill facility continues to be consistent with the design standards established in the current version of OAC 3745-27-08 of the Administrative Code."

In order to maintain compliance with OAC 3745-27-19(N), the Facility's Ten Year Design Demonstration submittal was due to Ohio EPA no later than May 18, 2009. As of the date of this letter, Ohio EPA has not received Countywide's Ten Year Design Demonstration. Therefore, the Facility's failure to submit this demonstration is a violation of OAC Rule 3745-27-19(N).

Please respond to the above violation within 14 days of receipt of this letter.

Nothing in this letter shall be construed to authorize any waiver from any requirements of applicable state solid waste laws or regulations. This letter shall not be interpreted to release MPG and GHLFP or others from responsibility under ORC Chapters 3704., 3714., 3734., or 6111; under the Federal Clean Water Act, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, or the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act; or from other applicable requirements for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
