OPEN DUMPING

Dear Mr. Gossman:

On March 9, 2011, I, representing the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), observed a large open dump on property located to the east of State Route 644 and to the south of Dobson Road in Franklin Township, Columbiana County, Ohio. Columbiana County property records indicate that you are the owner of these properties. I did not observe anyone at this property at the time of this inspection.

Upon completing my inspection, I determined that the following violations of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) existed at your property:

1. **Open Dumping of Solid Waste:** During this inspection large amounts of solid waste, including but not limited to, motor vehicle bodies, appliances, scrap tires, 55 gallon drums, televisions, heavy machinery bodies, miscellaneous metals, and miscellaneous solid wastes, among other things, were observed open dumped on this property.

The open dumping of solid waste on this property is a violation of the following laws and rules:

- **ORC Section 3734.03:** *"No person shall dispose of solid wastes by open burning or open dumping..."*
- **ORC Section 3734.11(A):** *"No person shall violate any section of this chapter, any rule adopted under it, or any order issued under section 3734.13 of the Revised Code."*
- **ORC Section 3734.02(C):** *"...no person shall establish a new solid waste facility...without submitting an application for a permit...and receiving a permit issued by the director..."*

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- **ORC Section 3734.05(A)(1)**: "...no person shall operate or maintain a solid waste facility without a license issued under this division...by the director of environmental protection..."
- **ORC Section 3734.05(A)(2)**: "...each person proposing to open a new solid waste facility...shall submit an application for a permit...to the environmental protection agency for required approval under the rules adopted under division (D) of section 3734.121 of the Revised Code at least two hundred seventy days before proposed operation of the facility..."
- **OAC Rule 3745-27-05(C)**: "No person shall conduct, permit, or allow open dumping."
- **OAC Rule 3745-37-01(A)**: "No person shall conduct municipal solid waste landfill...operations without possessing a separate, valid license for each such operation, as required by Chapter 3734. of the Revised Code and the Administrative Code rules adopted thereunder. Each license shall be obtained from...the director..."

In order to return to compliance with all applicable laws and rules, the owner(s) of this property must immediately remove all solid waste open dumped on this property and properly dispose of it in a licensed solid waste disposal facility. Metal items may be taken to a licensed salvage dealer to be recycled. Scrap tires must be transported via registered scrap tire transporter to a licensed scrap tire disposal facility. Receipts providing proof of disposal at a licensed solid waste facility, licensed salvage dealer, and licensed scrap tire disposal facility must be provided to Ohio EPA. The owner(s) of this property must also take all necessary measures to prevent solid waste from being open dumped on this property at all times in the future.

I have received no written correspondence from you in response to my previous Notices of Violation. Please address the above violations immediately, and notify me, ***in writing***, within **15** days of receiving this letter, indicating the measures which have been taken to correct these violations and what measures will be taken in order to prevent future illegal activities from taking place on this property. You have left messages on my voice mail in the past, but you have not left a telephone number where I can return your calls. If you leave a message on my voice mail, please leave a telephone number where I can return your calls. If I do not hear from you, I must assume that you do not wish to have a dialogue regarding this issue.

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Failure to correct the above violations in an expedient manner may result in escalated enforcement action being recommended against the owner(s) of this property by Ohio EPA.

Nothing in this letter shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable state or federal laws or regulations. This letter shall not be interpreted to release you, the owner(s) of this property, or others, from responsibility under Chapters 3704., 3714., 3734., or 6111. of the Ohio Revised Code or under the Federal Clean Water or Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Acts remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.

Once again, I would appreciate the opportunity to meet with you at your property in order to discuss the requirements of this letter and to answer any questions you may have regarding this letter. 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
