Dear Mr. Lewis:

On May 31, 2007, I (Jarnal Singh), representing the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency's (Ohio EPA) Division of Solid and Infectious Waste Management (DSIWM), conducted an inspection of your Class II Scrap Tire Recovery Facility located at 1165 Brittain Street, Youngstown. The purpose for the inspection was to determine compliance with Chapter 3745-27-65 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) and Director's Final Findings and Orders (DFF&Os) issued March 5, 2007. James Mixon representing RRI, accompanied me on the inspection.

RRI was determined to be in compliance with Orders 1 through 3 of the March 5, 2007 DFF&Os. However, RRI is in violation of Order 9 of the March 5, 2007, DFF&Os.

Order 9 of the DFF&Os issued March 5, 2007, states in part: "Within sixty (60) days after the effective date of these Orders, Respondent shall pay the first civil penalty installment in the amount of \$833.60. Respondent shall continue to make payments in the amount of \$833.60 every thirty days, thereafter, until the full amount of the penalty has been paid."

RRI failed to pay the 1st civil payment penalty installment of \$833.60, which was due on May 4, 2007. Please ensure that immediate actions are taken to comply with Order 9 of the DFF&Os.

Nothing in this letter shall be construed to authorize any waiver from any requirements of applicable state solid waste laws or regulations. This letter shall not be interpreted to release the owner or operator of the facility or others from responsibility under ORC Chapters 3704., 3714., 3734. or 6111; under the Federal Clean Water Act, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, or the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act; or from other applicable requirements for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
