Dear Ms. Burlingame:

This letter provides a notice of violation from Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) regarding Goodyear-Seiberling Street Landfill, located southeast of the intersection of Seiberling Street and the Little Cuyahoga River, Akron, in Summit County. The violation is listed below:

Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-27-14(A)(4) states in part, "*Post-closure care activities for a sanitary landfill facility shall include, but are not limited to the following: . . . Quarterly inspection of a sanitary landfill facility during each year of the post-closure care period and submittal of a written summary to the appropriate Ohio EPA district office not later than fifteen days after the inspection date detailing the results of the inspection and a schedule of any actions to be taken to maintain compliance with paragraphs (A)(1) and (A)(2) of this rule.*"

Goodyear is in violation of OAC 3745-27-14(A)(4) because Ohio EPA did not receive the quarterly inspection report in a timely manner. Ohio EPA received a quarterly inspection report on July 26, 2007. However, the report was for a landfill inspection on June 18, 2007. Please send each quarterly landfill inspection report within 15 days of the inspection date. Nothing in this letter shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable state or federal laws or regulations. This letter shall not be interpreted to release Goodyear from responsibility under Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111 of the Ohio Revised Code or under the Federal Clean Water or Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Acts for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
