Return to compliance – Large Generator Inspection Correspondence

Dear Ms. Allman:

On March 1, 2011, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Southwest District Office received and reviewed a corrective action response letter from Darlene Fletcher, Atrium Medical Center, Manager of Environmental Services on behalf of the Chronic Dialysis Center (Facility) located at 4421 Roosevelt Blvd, Middletown, Ohio. This correspondence was submitted in response to the Notice of Violation (NOV) letter issued by Ohio EPA, dated February 1, 2011. Prior to receipt of the hard copy of the response letter, I received a copy via electronic mail on February 24, 2011, from Ms. Fletcher.

Included with the response letter was a photograph showing the removal of the "used sharps boxes" that were found during the January 19, 2011 inspection beneath plastic pallets used to lift the infectious waste packaged for disposal in infectious waste storage room. Additionally, a copy of the revised infectious waste spill containment/cleanup procedure was provided and upon review meets the requirements of OAC Rule 3745-27-30(B)(10). Atrium Medical Center as the registrant for this Facility has requested an amendment to their Ohio EPA infectious waste generator registration certificate to address the Facility name change.

Please continue to educate staff on the importance of proper management of infectious waste. Thank you for your cooperation in resolving the violations cited. If you have any questions, please contact me at (937) 285-6046.
