**RE: Return to Compliance-Open Dumping
Property located at 7950 Seward Road, Butler County**

Dear Mr. Wunnenberg:

On July 12, 2007, Monte Bluebaum and I representing the Ohio EPA, Southwest District Office (SWDO), Division of Solid and Infectious Waste Management (DSIWM), conducted a follow-up inspection of the property located at 7950 Seward Road (parcel no. A0300007000003). The purpose of this follow-up inspection was to determine compliance with Ohio's Solid Waste Laws, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3734 and Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3734.

I inspected the site to verify that the clean up had been completed. Solid wastes which include the scrap tires have been removed from the aforementioned parcel. Construction and demolition debris has also been removed from the property. The violations previously described in the Notice of Violation letter dated, January 25, 2007, have been abated.

Thank you for your cooperation in resolving the complaint of open dumping of solid waste, scrap tires and construction and demolition debris at 7950 Seward Road, Fairfield Township, Butler County, Ohio. I received fax copies of receipts submitted in response to my letter dated, January 25, 2007, which was a result of a complaint investigation conducted on the aforementioned parcel. These receipts were submitted as documentation of your cleanup efforts at 7950 Seward Road (Parcel No. A0300007000003), Butler County, Ohio.

Please continue routine policing of the property to help avoid future violations. Please be advised that it is the property owner's responsibility to cleanup any solid wastes including but not limited to scrap tires and/or construction and demolition debris that may be illegally dumped on site.

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Clean hard fill remains on the property and Ohio EPA, Southwest District Office received a Notice of Intent to Fill for this parcel. As a reminder, if the point of generation or work timeframe changes a new NOI Form will need to be submitted seven (7) days prior to fill activities beginning.

Compliance with the requirements outlined in this letter shall not relieve you of your obligation to comply with other legal obligations, including, but not limited to, Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111 of the Ohio Revised Code or under the Federal Clean Water Act, Clean Air Act, Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act, or Resource Conservation and Recovery Act remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
