Dear Mr. Nytra:

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Northeast District Office (NEDO) has completed a review of the March 27, 2007 document titled *2006 Annual Operational Report, Carbon Limestone Sanitary Landfill, Poland Township, Mahoning County*. The document was received on March 28, 2007. An addendum to the annual report was received June 1, 2007.

Ohio EPA has identified the following violations.

1. OAC 3745-27-19(M)(1): The 'Annual Operational Report' shall include, at a minimum. A topographic map of the unit(s) of the sanitary landfill facility...

The annual report received at Ohio EPA on March 28, 2007 did not contain the topographic map required by this rule. The map was later submitted with the Addendum dated May 30, 2007.

2. OAC 3745-27-19(M)(3): The 'Annual Operational Report' shall include...An estimate of the remaining sanitary landfill facility life, in years, and in terms of the remaining volume of the sanitary landfill facility to be filled, in cubic yards.

The annual report received at Ohio EPA on March 28, 2007 did not contain the required estimate of remaining life. The estimate was later submitted with the Addendum dated May 30, 2007.

Ohio EPA has identified the following deficiencies.

3. Transferred Waste sheets do not show the facility name.

Please note that ground water information included with the report is reviewed separately. Any comments or concerns regarding ground water information will be forwarded in a separate letter. Please submit a response to this letter by February 14, 2008.
