Dear Mr. Brunner:

I have received your November 2, 2011 letter which responded to the violations and concerns found during the August 16, 2011 inspection of Auto Salvation located at 550 Ohio Avenue, in Ravenna, Ohio. Your letter included photos of the recent cleanup of used oil contamination. Also submitted was a manifest showing the September 27, 2011 pickup of used oil and waste antifreeze by Akron Canton Waste Oil. It is assumed that this waste pickup included the material in the containers mentioned in Ohio EPA's August 29, 2011 letter.

Your letter and its attachments documented the correction of the following used oil violations that were found:

1. **OAC rule 3745-279-22(C) - Used oil labels.**
2. **OAC Rule 3745-279-22(D) - Response to releases of used oil.**

A re-inspection of the property will be made shortly to determine the degree of compliance concerning the scrap tires and solid waste issues. Questions regarding these issues should be directed to Jarnal Singh at (330) 963-1276.
