
Dear Mr. Cassidy:

Thank you for your letter dated October 11, 2011, responding to my letter dated September 12, 2011. Concerning your violation of **Variance Condition 2.k.**, we understand Agmet plans to send the two roll-off boxes of mixed filters, as well as any possible chrome filters from the bunker inside the bulk storage building, to a permitted hazardous waste disposal facility. On October 28, 2011, we received an e-mail from Conrad Hornung indicating inclement weather has delayed this activity. On October 31, 2011, we acknowledged his request to submit documentation of removal of this material to a permitted hazardous waste facility by November 30, 2011.

In response to our concern of potentially inappropriate materials being sent to Agmet, Agmet has sent a letter to its supplying customers further clarifying management and evaluation of incidental filters. Also Agmet states it will include additional annual training on this topic for its Shipping and Receiving personnel. Thank you for addressing this concern.
