**RE: *FORMER LAKE ERIE PRODUCTS, OHD004189817, CUYAHOGA COUNTY
CESSATION OF REGULATED OPERATIONS, 2nd NOTICE OF VIOLATION***

Dear Mr. Bostain:

You have failed to respond to Ohio EPA's September 9, 2010 Notice of Violation (NOV). On July 26, 2006, Lake Erie Products filed a one year temporary Cessation of Regulated Operations (CRO) notification with Ohio EPA for its now former Lake Erie Products facility located at 13001 Athens Avenue, Lakewood, Ohio (see attached). Lake Erie Products never re-started operations at the location.

Lake Erie Products failed to file the *Regulated Substance and Equipment Removal EPA Form 0329*.

As a result, Lake Erie Products is in violation of the following Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule:

**Responsibilities of owner/operator within 90-days of CRO
OAC 3745-352-20(2)(a), (b), and (g)**

1. *Submit to the director a copy of the most recent chemical inventory report required by section 3750.08 of the Ohio Revised Code.*
2. *Submit to the director a copy of the current hazardous chemicals list or each of the material safety data sheets required by section 3750.07 of the Ohio revised Code:*
3. *Certify to the director that you have complied with this rule using form EPA 0329*
